The Community of Lay Ministers (CLM) is made up of intentional servants, members of ELCA churches in the Southwestern Washington Synod, who have completed a 2-year study program (biblical studies, Lutheran confessions, church history and practical theology) that equips lay people for ministry in their local settings. It is designed to enhance the ministry of lay people who are already serving their congregations in effective ways. There is an application process. When successfully completed, the Synod certifies the participants are eligible to be commissioned to serve in their congregations in specific ministries, determined in consultation with the pastor.
