



Youth Scholarship Awarded

In March, the Calvary Lutheran Church (CLC) Council announced the inception of a scholarship to be awarded annually to CLC high school aged youth to participate in a Lutheran-based leadership or ministry program, conference, or camp to further their faith development, talents and leadership skills.

For 2011, the CLC Council has awarded a \$500 scholarship to Elizabeth Chamberlain.

Elizabeth has been accepted into the Lutheran Summer Music program at Luther College in Decorah, Iowa and

will apply the scholarship money toward her tuition. The program runs from the end of June to the end of July 2011. In her application letter to the Council, Elizabeth stated the benefits of the program: "I believe that LSM will be a great opportunity to build on my knowledge as a musician, leader, and as a member of the congregation, and will help me to transfer these skills to both music and worship settings. At LSM I will be able to take classes that will give me the opportunity to plan worship services, learn about the history of the Lutheran Church, grow in my understanding of hymns and hymnals, and participate in multiple worship services, as well as explore many aspects of music (such as music theory)."
